## About Family Strengthening Program

The Family Strengthening Program (FSP), spearheaded by The **Ministry of Gender, Children, and Social Welfare** in collaboration with the **National Social Protection Secretariat**, is a strategic initiative designed to provide essential support to the country's most vulnerable populations. With a commitment to disbursing monthly cash transfers of **GMD 1,000** to alleviate economic pressures, the FSP focuses on four primary groups: individuals with multiple disabilities, the elderly, orphans without parents, and female-led households. Targeting **at least 2,000** vulnerable individuals, the FSP aims to significantly improve their quality of life and ensure a level of financial stability and welfare enhancement across these key demographics.
